



Confidentiality

Confidentiality is vital to the free and candid discussion necessary for effective assessment and treatment. It involves respecting and maintaining the confidentiality of all discussions, deliberations, records and other information generated in connection with the Shelter. It also means safeguarding information about the child and family that has been obtained in the course of one's role as a professional. This information should be shared only with others who are involved with the child and/or family on a professional basis. Furthermore, such information must be shared in a professional manner and only when it serves the best interests of the child and/or family.

Upholding confidentiality applies to the Board of Directors, Staff, Volunteers and Interns of Safe Harbor Children's Center, Inc.

Included is all information regarding residents, former residents, staff and former staff.
